



# Set-up the Libby App

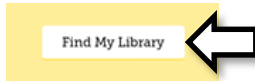
## 1. Get the App



In your app store, search for **Libby**, by **OverDrive Labs**  
Install and open the app.

## 2. Connect to Bridges

Tap **Find My Library**. The app will try to determine your library using your current location. If it's not the correct one, search by zip code or library name.

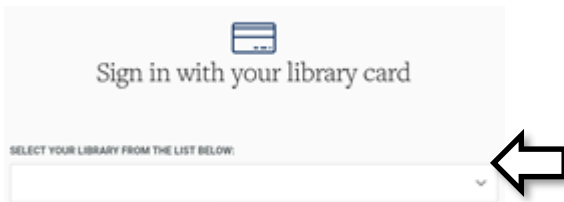


## 3. Sign in with your Library Card

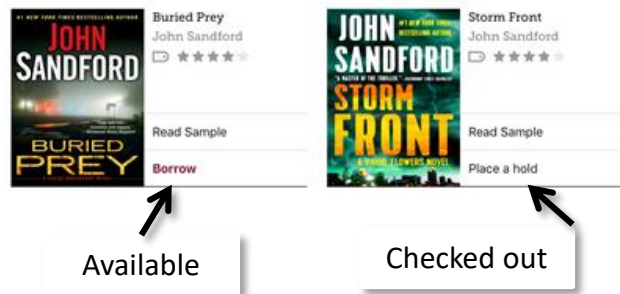

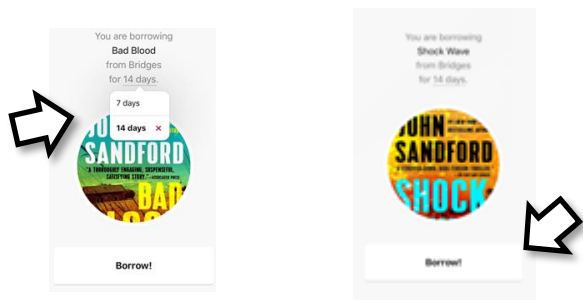
# How to Borrow eBooks & audiobooks

1. Browse or Search to find a title to read

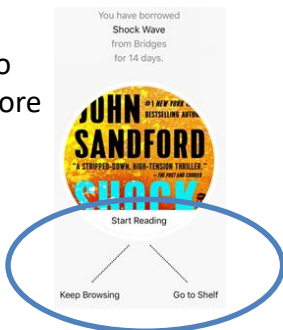


2. Tap **Borrow** to checkout immediately or touch the cover image to read more about the book.

3. Set your loan period here then **Borrow**.



4. Start reading immediately, go to your shelf or do more browsing.



5. Swipe or tap right side of screen to turn the page

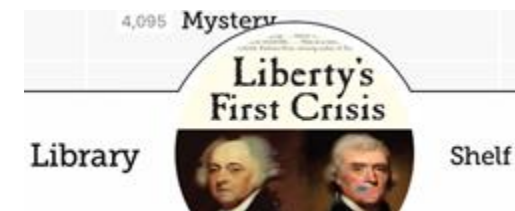
Next, he would restrict the press, ignore the rights of man, advance tyranny and despotism, support large banks and monopolies over farmers, build standing armies and navies to intimidate the people into submission, and engage in unnecessary wars - changes he believed fit Adams to a tee.

This article caught the eye of a Sanbury resident named Charles Hall. Adams had appointed Hall in 1797 as a position arbitrating disputes over British and American debts. As one of Timothy Pickering's trusted informers, Hall mailed the article to the secretary of Pickering, thinking that for exposing "the Cooper's mischievous address." Pickering set out to punish both Cooper and Priestley, whose role in returning Cooper was "unpardonable." "It once thought of him as a persecuted Christian," Pickering wrote. "But I am now satisfied that ambitious influence him." Pickering decided that despotism would be the best way to deal with Priestley, who had yet to apply for U.S. citizenship. Cooper was a different matter, since he had recently become an American citizen. To Pickering, such was a more technicality. Cooper was with a "stronger" "standing with me

6. Tap center of the screen for options



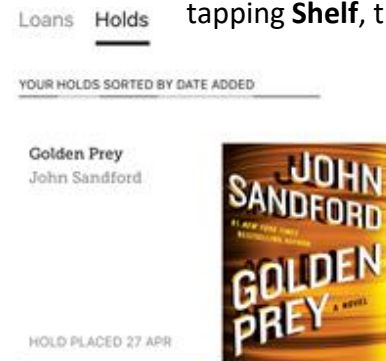
6. From the bottom of most pages, there is a link back to the **Library** (Bridges), your **Shelf** or directly to the book you're currently reading.



7. Check the status of books you currently have checked out by tapping **Shelf**, then **Loans**.



8. Check the status of books you've reserved by tapping **Shelf**, then **Holds**.
